Getting Here

By Car

Take the Princes Fwy M1 from Melbourne CBD or Geelong.

By Train

Werribee and Surrounds is serviced by regular Metro and V/Line train services and buses. Visit Public Transport Victoria (ptv.vic.gov.au) to plan your journey.

By Air

Werribee is an easy drive from Melbourne Airport (40 minutes) and Avalon Airport (20 minutes) and is serviced by the SkyBus airport shuttle.

By Boat

Wyndham Harbour marina provides mooring for yachts, powerboats and jet skis. Werribee and Surrounds is a short drive from the Spirit of Tasmania Quay ferry terminal in Geelong.



WERRIBEE PARK MANSION

Step back in time and take a tour of the beautifully restored 60-room Roman Renaissance style mansion, which was built in the 1870s by Scottish pastoralists, Thomas and Andrew Chirnside.

Visitors can enjoy self-guided tours, or pre-booked group tours with a guide, including tours in Cantonese and Mandarin. Guided tours for people with low vision or blindness can also be arranged.

Allow time to explore the stunning gardens, Werribee Park Community Farm with its flourishing vegetable gardens and the Werribee Park Heritage Orchard, which dates back to the Chirnside family.

Entry to the gardens is free, with a small admission fee for Mansion entry.

WERRIBEE OPEN RANGE ZOO

Bring your curiosity to life at Werribee Open Range Zoo.

Experience an African adventure on over 200 hectares within the Werribee Park Precinct.

Hop on a free Safari Bus Tour spotting rhinos, giraffes, zebra, ostriches, antelope and bison! Walk the Australian Trail and say g'day to the kangaroos, emus, koalas, and more and visit the historic Chirnside Woolshed.

On the African River Trail you'll meet gorillas, cheetah, hippos and a majestic pride of lions.

Immerse yourself with a behind-the-scenes Animal Experience or the unique, all-inclusive Slumber Safari.

Kids under 16 visit free on weekends, school holidays and public holidays.

LANCEMORE MANSION HOTEL WERRIBEE PARK

Located in the wing of Werribee Park Mansion, this luxury hotel oozes indulgence, with Victoria State Rose Garden, Shadowfax Winery and Werribee Open Range Zoo just a short stroll away.

THE REFECTORY PARLOUR


Garden dining at its best.

VICTORIA STATE ROSE GARDEN

See more than 5,000 roses in bloom!

This spectacular garden is the perfect spot for a romantic picnic or family get-together.

Visit between October to April to see the blooms at their best and appreciate the unique garden design, with the garden beds forming the shape of a rose.

Entry is free, with donations welcome to support the work of the volunteers who maintain the garden.

Help protect the garden for future generations. When taking photos, please stay on the grassed areas to avoid damaging the delicate root systems in the garden beds.

SHADOWFAX WINERY

Savour premium local wines at one of Melbourne's best cellar doors.

The rich red soils of Werribee provide the perfect base for growing Shiraz, Carignan, Grenache, Mataro and Roussanne grapes, with this boutique winery also specialising in award-winning Macedon Chardonnay, Pinot Gris and Pinot Noir.

You can taste your way through their line-up of current estate and single vineyard wines or indulge in a long and leisurely lunch in the popular dining room with a menu of Mediterranean inspired dishes, share plates and wood-fired pizzas. There's live music on Friday nights and weekends and a casual outdoor area with views of the vineyard and rolling lawns.

RAAF MUSEUM

Explore one of the best collections of historical aircraft in the world.

Head to the free RAAF Museum and get a close look at fighter jets, helicopters, propeller planes and more!

Massive hangars house original and replica aircraft celebrating the history of the Royal Australian Air Force, founded right here at the base back in 1914.

Head to visitwerribee.com for opening days, flying times and details.

B-24 LIBERATOR

Aviation buffs should also check out the B-24 Liberator Memorial Australia – a working museum, where volunteers are restoring one of just eight remaining Liberators in the world. Open Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

WYNDHAM HARBOUR

Stroll along the waterfront and admire the luxury yachts and powerboats in the marina, before tackling the mini golf course at The Elements Coastal Activity Park or grabbing lunch with a view at 3030 Boulevard.







NATURE & OUTDOORS

Go for a walk, head out on the water or find relaxation on the golfing green.



FROM RIVER TO SEA

SWIMMING & BEACHES

The sea breeze in your hair, saltwater and the afternoon stretching out in front of you, with nowhere else to be.

Werribee South Foreshore is a popular spot for families with a swimming beach, boat ramps and fishing jetty, playgrounds, barbeques and a shared walking and cycling trail that will take you all the way to Wyndham Harbour.

Further along the bay you'll find Point Cook Coastal Park, with a narrow sandy beach, shaded picnic areas and barbeques.

The swimming beaches at Werribee South Foreshore and Point Cook Coastal Park are generally unpatrolled, with visitors encouraged to check safety conditions at beachsafe.org.au and water quality with epa.vic.gov.au before they visit.



CHEETHAM WETLANDS

Popular with birdwatchers, Cheetham Wetlands also makes for an easy, family-friendly walk.

The 3 kilometre return walk leads to an observation tower where you can take in the patchwork of saltmarsh and lagoons, with uninterrupted views across Port Phillip Bay towards Melbourne's skyline.

POINT COOKE MARINE SANCTUARY

Bottlenose dolphins, sea urchins and schools of colourful fish – discover an underwater world teaming with life.

Point Cooke is Victoria's largest marine sanctuary and a great spot to dive and snorkel with the rocky reefs and eelgrass beds a haven for the bay's marine life including sponges, colourful algae, rays and small sharks.

Divers and snorkellers can also explore two heritage-listed shipwrecks beneath the waves - the Henrietta and the Diana.

CAMPBELLS COVE

Admire the row of colourful boatsheds that have brightened the foreshore since the 1920s.

FISHING & BOATING

Werribee South Foreshore and Boat Ramp is very popular for boating and fishing. Visitor berths are also available at Wyndham Harbour with overnight, weekly and monthly options.

KAYAKING & SUP

Looking for a new spot to explore with your kayak or stand up paddle board? There are two popular launching sites which provide access to Werribee River and Port Phillip Bay – Riverbend Historical Park and Werribee South Foreshore. These routes are recommended for experienced kayakers and paddlers.

SHORT WALKS & BIKE TRAILS

WYNDHAM BAY TRAIL

This shared trail hugs the coastline between Werribee South Foreshore and Wyndham Harbour, with bay views, playgrounds, public toilets and an ice-cream pit stop.

WYNDHAM PARK LOOP

If you've got kids in tow – Wyndham Park on the banks of Werribee River is a must! As well as two large playgrounds and nature play areas, you'll find broad concrete and gravel pathways that loop and crisscross the park, with connections to the longer Werribee River Trail.

BAY TRAIL

Looking for a longer ride? From the City you can use the Westgate Punt to cross the Yarra River and connect with the coastal Bay Trail via Spotswood, Williamstown and Altona all the way to Cheetham Wetlands and Point Cook Coastal Park.

FEDERATION TRAIL

Arrive by bike! Works are currently underway to connect the Federation Trail between Werribee and Brooklyn to Yarraville, with links to Melbourne's CBD.

BIRDWATCHING, GOLF & MORE

TAKE FLIGHT

Experience the thrill of flying and take to the skies with a tandem aerochute (powered parachutes) with Aerochute International.

BIRDWATCHING

Join twitchers from far and wide who head to Cheetham Wetlands, Point Cook Coastal Park and the Western Treatment Plant to catch a glimpse of more than 300 bird species.

With some migratory shorebirds flying in from as far as Siberia, Japan and Alaska, these wetlands are among Australia's top birdwatching sites, with the Western Treatment Plant recognised internationally under the Ramsar Convention

A birdwatching permit is required to access the Western Treatment Plant with online applications via melbournewater.com.au and access key pick up from the Werribee Visitor Information Centre. For a guided experience book a tour with Melbourne Birding Tours or Firetail Birdwatching Tours.

GOLF

Tee off at Sanctuary Lakes Golf Club or Werribee Park Golf Club, both of which offer a championship length course, public bookings and hire options.

K ROAD CLIFFS

Take in the view.

The K Road Cliffs are a breathtaking wall of red by day and even more impressive at dusk as they change colour with the setting sun.

Head to the lookout at the top of the cliffs to enjoy views across the Werribee River, with the peaked outline of the You Yangs forming an impressive background against the red clay of the cliffs.

Works are planned to protect the cliff geology and to improve walking trails and car parking, so check visitwerribee.com for any potential closures before your visit.

YOU YANGS REGIONAL PARK

Little River is the gateway to the granite peaks of You Yangs Regional Park, with more than 50 kilometres of mountain bike trails, great walks, birdlife and views. Explore the heritage gems of the bluestone Rothwell Bridge and Little River Mechanics Institute and enjoy the country hospitality of the Little River Hotel.





FAMILY ADVENTURES

Big adventures for all ages.



WERRIBEE OPEN RANGE ZOO

Werribee Open Range Zoo should of course be on your bucket list.

A visit to the Zoo isn't complete without a safari through the savannah! Climb aboard the big bus and be transported through the open plains of Africa.

Stroll along the trails at your own speed, spotting lions, hippos, cheetah, monkeys, gorillas and more and catch the daily Crazy about Cats Keeper Talk, where you can learn about one of Africa's best hunters, the serval.

PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

Pack your picnic rug – when it comes to parks and playgrounds, Werribee has some of the best!

Werribee Park Mansion, Victoria State Rose Garden, Point Cook Coastal Park and Wyndham Park are great options for families and groups, with plenty of shady spots and loads of space to run around.
